



## \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy - Special Conditions

Weights: Colts & Geldings - 57kg Fillies - 55kg, plus Penalties (in each case) as per the NZTR Standard Regulations for Racemeeting Programmes (No Allowances).

Nominations for the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy are required to be made with the National Racing Bureau by 12 noon on Monday, 3 March 2025 and withdrawals must be made with the National Racing Bureau by 10 am on Tuesday, 4 March 2025.

Up to four horses that are acceptors for the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy will be declared as emergency runners for the NZB Kiwi to be held on Saturday, 8 March 2025, provided they are eligible to run in the NZB Kiwi under the conditions of that race. The horses to be declared as emergency runners for the NZB Kiwi will be chosen by NZTR or the NZB Kiwi Race Committee in accordance the conditions of the NZB Kiwi. If a horse that is an acceptor for the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy gains a start in the NZB Kiwi as a result of a horse scratching from that race, the horse will be scratched from the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy by NZTR and must run in the NZB Kiwi instead. The declaration of emergencies for the NZB Kiwi will be a listing only and not an order of entry in the event of a scratching in the NZB Kiwi. The selection of the listed emergency runner that replaces any horse that has been scratched from the NZB Kiwi will be made by the relevant slot holder from the list of available emergency runners declared for the NZB Kiwi. The owners' share of prizemoney for emergency runners gaining a start in the NZB Kiwi will be divided between the relevant slot holder and the owners of the emergency runner in accordance with the conditions for the NZB Kiwi.

Strict conditions apply to the scratching of horses from the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy. Horses that are acceptors for the \$100,000 Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy may only be scratched from the race in the following circumstances:

- (a) to contest the NZB Kiwi, if selected from the list of emergency runners declared for the NZB Kiwi;
- (b) with a certified veterinary certificate approved for that purpose by NZTR in its absolute discretion; or
- (c) as otherwise approved by the NZB Kiwi Race Committee, acting reasonably.
